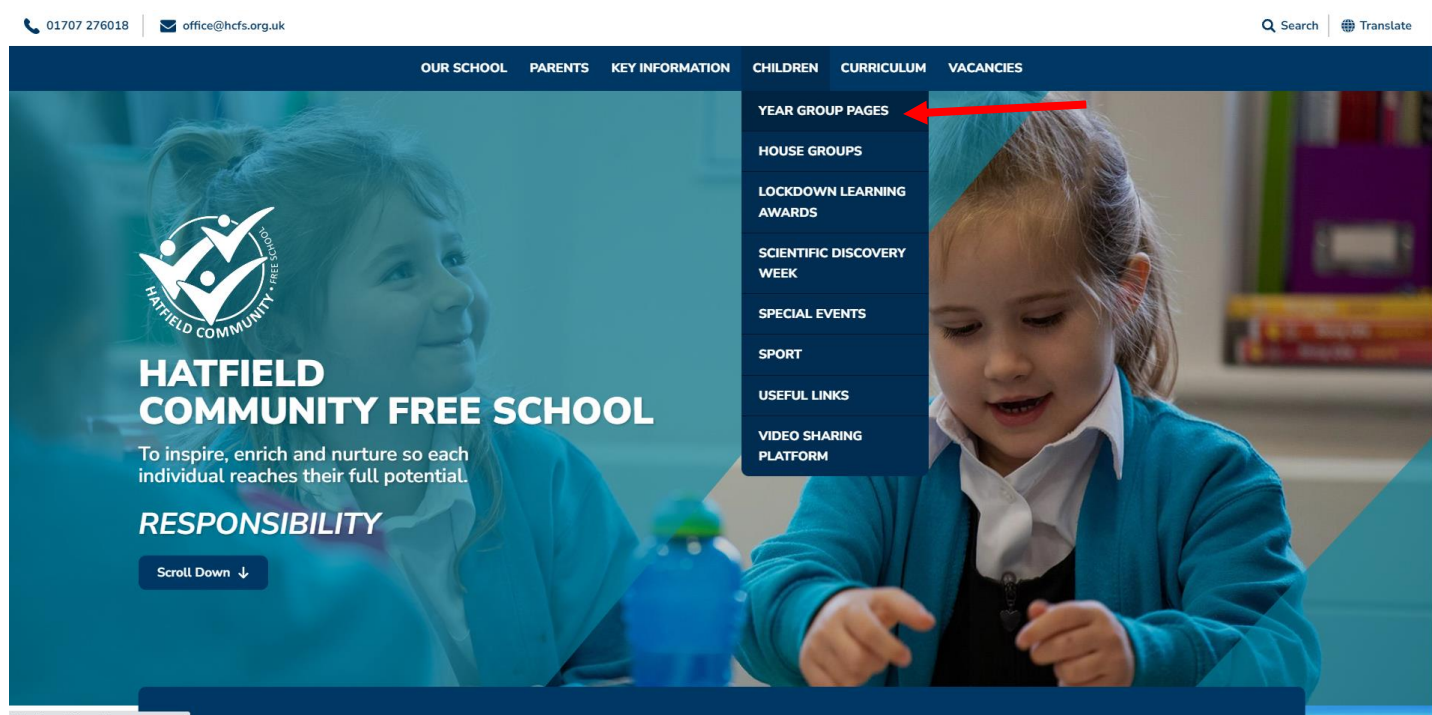
Year Group Information and Messages

Year One	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Please make sure reading books and reading record books are bought in every day. We will change readers every Friday.PE Kits: Please ensure your child's PE kit is labelled clearly.PE days for year 1: Monday and Wednesday
Year Two	<ul style="list-style-type: none">This week the children will be completing their first Year 2 checkpoints. The results of these will be shared with you on parents evening.Not everyone had their PE kits this week. Please ensure these are returned to school as soon as possible and containing indoor and outdoor PE kit options.Please check your children's uniforms, particularly jumpers, to ensure they have the correct ones as I have had a few parents say that their children's named uniforms have gone missing.

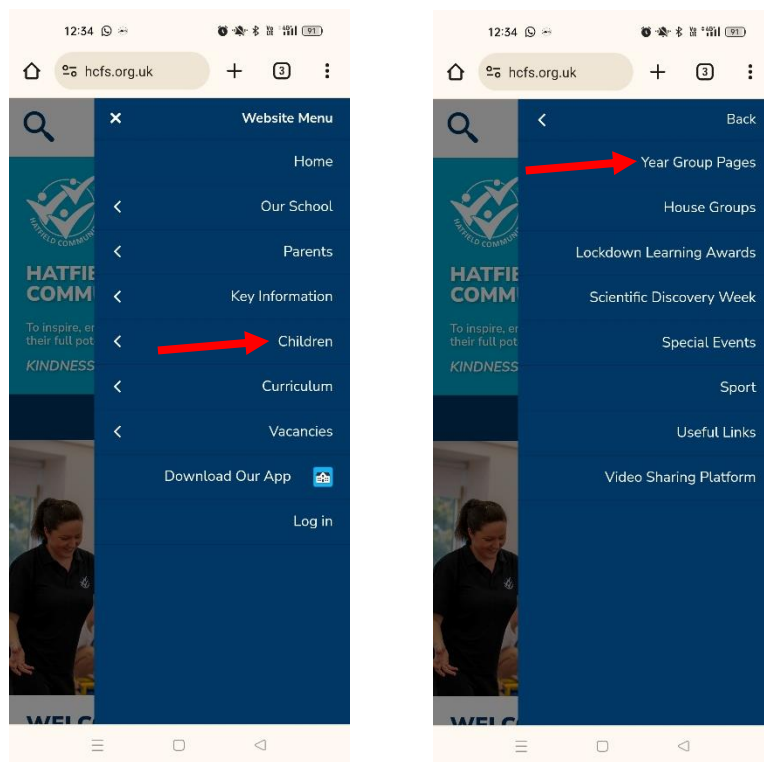
