We are delighted to be writing to you today to share our KS2 SATs results from this year:

The KS2 SATs are a national assessment used to measure primary school performance. Nationally, this year's results indicate that children are catching up on learning post-pandemic. In most subjects, a higher proportion of pupils reached the expected standard compared to last year.

As can be seen from the results above, this year's year six cohort of children at HCFS have achieved above the national average in all areas, with a particular strength showing in our children's reading attainment with 91.5% of the cohort achieving at least the expected standard.

As a school, we are thrilled of this set of results and could not be prouder of the children and staff who have all worked so hard to achieve them.
