## Additional Information:

SMSC is defined in the Ofsted School Inspection handbook November 2019:

Spiritual Development - the ability to be reflective about children's own beliefs and perspective on life, as well as knowledge of and respect for other people's faiths, feelings and values.

Moral Development - the ability to recognise the difference between right and wrong and to readily apply this to everyday life. Children also gain an understanding of the consequences of their behaviour and actions.

Social Development - willingness to participate in a variety of communities and social settings, including by volunteering, cooperating well with others and being able to resolve conflicts effectively. It also includes acceptance and engagement with the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.

Cultural Development - gaining an understanding and appreciation of the wide range of cultural influences that have shaped children's own heritage and that of others. Having an ability to recognise and value the things we share in common across cultural, religious, ethnic and socio-economic communities.


