

## Reading Awards and Challenges at HCFS

There will be three reading challenges set across the academic year, end of Autumn Term, Spring Term and Summer Term. The children will receive house points for completing these challenges.

Parents will be notified a week before the deadline and it will be the class teachers responsibility to collect these in at the end of each term and give out the house points.

### Autumn Term Reading Challenge

**Begins: W/C 15<sup>th</sup> September 2025    Ends: Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025**

**Reading bingo** – 30 challenges for children to complete over the course of the autumn term. They can complete 10, 20 or all 30 challenges.

10 challenges – 3 house points

20 challenges – 6 house points

30 Challenges – 10 house points

### Spring Term Challenge

**Begins: W/C 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026    Ends: Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2026**

**Reading around the world** – Can you travel to all 7 continents and earn as many house points as you can? You will have a reading passport to records pages and miles.

| Europe        | 250          | 1                   |
| Africa        | 350          | 2                   |
| Asia          | 400          | 3                   |
| North America | 500          | 4                   |
| South America | 650          | 5                   |
| Australia     | 700          | 6                   |
| Antarctica    | 1000         | 7                   |

#### **Alphabet reading**

**Challenge 1** – Can you read 26 books, each beginning with a different letter from the alphabet? Earn yourself house points by completing this challenge:

7 letters – 4 house points

13 letters – 6 house points

26 letters – 8 house points

**Challenge 2** – Read your way through the alphabet by the author's last name.

Earn yourself house points by completing this challenge:

7 letters – 4 house points

13 letters – 6 house points

26 letters – 8 house points
