Engaging with the online platforms for a maximum of 30 minutes in total (we don't expect 30 mins on each!)



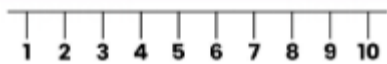
Could Do

Can you grow something, maybe a sunflower, some cress or some flowers? You could plant them in your garden or a pot in your house.

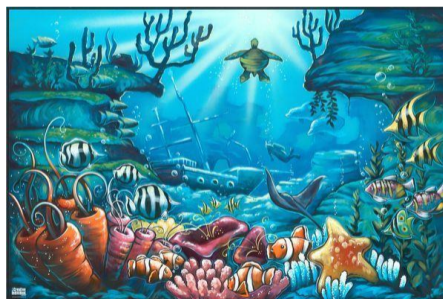
**Project (The animal kingdom)**
