External events were at a high point last year. The school attended 30 + events due to our paid partnership with Onslow St Audrey school, alongside the School Games Events. All pupils took part in the Daily Mile, 2 weekly PE sessions & various sports club from internal or external sources. A mass of enrichment opportunities provided by different external companies such as Premier Education, Stevenage Boro Foundation & more. Sports Council & Sports Ambassador's being introduced efficiently, with a scheme set up for the upcoming year. SEND interventions targeting those with low engagement in PE due to various reasons.	Children receiving medals/certificates for either winning the events or finishing in a high position. All Teachers are provided with PE Plans by the sports coordinator, with adaptations needed per class. High uptake in external & internal clubs (found by the data). Pupil voice wanting more of the same external enrichment opportunities, with us now taking up Stevenage Foundation with an annual 6 week course for our Y5 students. Pupils are now engaged in lunchtime clubs which gives extra opportunity for children to take part in sport. Liaising with SENCO to approve of these & have the support throughout the programme.
